About The Performance: This handbook is for all performing classes in Concert and Cabaret, from Ballet I and intro level classes to advanced.

The *SPRING CONCERT*: will be held on *Saturday, May 17th, 2025* at SUNY Purchase. The Performances will be at 12:00 and 3:30pm

The *CABARET*: will be held on *Sunday, May 4, 2025* at Fox Lane High school in Bedford. The Performances will be at 12:00 and 3:30pm

PERFORMANCE LOCATION: CONCERT: SUNY Purchase **CABARET:** Fox Lane School in Bedford. Both facilities offer comfortable seating, handicap access, air conditioning, and convenient parking.

COMMITMENT TO PERFORMANCE: A completed Performance Commitment Form is needed promptly so that the instructors will know how many students are being choreographed into each piece. If your dancer is not performing, a complete Commitment Form is still needed. *I*t is vital that our Instructors have confirmation of whether they are performing or not asap.

- Deadline for commitment is <u>February 18th, 2025</u>. Payment due by <u>March 31, 2025</u>. If commitment and payment are not received by these dates, we cannot guarantee that student will be allowed to perform. <u>Note</u>: If your account is not up-to-date, participation fees and ticket purchases will not be accepted.

CONCERT PERFORMANCE COST:

- Participation Fee: The Participation Fee covers our additional insurance cost, rehearsal time, professional stage help and all professional video/ photography. Each performance of Concert & Cabaret is assessed separately.
- Costume Rental Fee: Costume Fee covers fittings, alterations, repairs and cleaning (Per Class)
 - *STANDARD* Price (Cost if payment are received by March 31) Participation Fee..... \$75.000 (Per Dancer) Costume Fee \$75.00 (Per Class)
 - *RUSH* Price (Cost if payment are received after March 31) Participation Fee \$90.00 (Per Dancer) Costume Fee \$90.00 (Per Class)

CABARET PERFORMANCE COST:

- Participation Fee: The Participation Fee covers our additional insurance cost, rehearsal time, professional stage help, and all professional video/ photography. Each performance of Concert & Cabaret is assessed separately.
- Costume Rental Fee: Costume Fee covers fittings, alterations, repairs and cleaning (Per Class)
 - *STANDARD* Price (Cost if payment are received by March 31) Participation Fee..... \$75.000 (Per Dancer) Costume Fee \$75.00 (Per Class)
 - *RUSH* Price (Cost if payment are received after March 31) Participation Fee \$90.00 (Per Dancer) Costume Fee \$90.00 (Per Class)

ATTENDANCE FOR CLASSES – Pieces are being prepared for the Performances. Rehearsals will be scheduled and posted on our website. These rehearsals are <u>NOT</u> mandatory but highly encouraged if able to attend. Your child's attendance in classes from now until the performance is very important. Rehearsals at the theater are <u>mandatory</u>. If your child misses these your child will NOT be able to participate. If you have any transportation issues for these mandatory rehearsals, please contact us ASAP to try and help facilitate.

COSTUMES: - Costumes for Concert will be fitted on specific date, to be announced. Cabaret costumes will be fitted in class. All costumes are supplied on a rental basis and will be in the students' dressing rooms on dress rehearsal and performance days.

- Costumes may not be taken out of the dressing rooms and should be returned to the room supervisor before you leave.
- A charge will be enforced if damaged costumes are returned.

CONCERT PERFORMANCE: - Saturday, May 17th, 2025 at SUNY Purchase

12:00pm Ballet A Level and above and ALL workshops - Arrive by: 10:00am ; Level BI to III - Arrive by 11:00am

3:30pm Ballet A level and above and all workshops - Should stay in between shows ; BIV to BVI - Arrive by show 2:30pm

- Dancers should come with hair and make-up done.
- Parents are not allowed backstage (unless volunteering). An LDA Assistant or volunteer will bring your child from the foyer to the backstage area.
- If your child is in more than one number, there will be LDA staff available to provide assistance.

CABARET PERFORMANCE: - Sunday, May 4th, 2025 at Fox Lane High School

12:00pm All Dancers in Act II and 42nd St - Arrive by 10am; All Others - Arrive by 11am

3:30pm All Dancers in Act II and 42nd St - Should stay in between shows; All Others - Arrive by 2:30pm

- Dancers should come with hair and make-up done
- Parents are not allowed backstage (unless volunteering). An LDA Assistant or volunteer will bring your child from the foyer to the backstage area.
- If your child is in more than one number there will be LDA staff available to provide assistance.

VOLUNTEERING: Volunteers are essential to having smooth and successful performances. Volunteers will be needed to help with costumes in the dressing rooms for the Dress Rehearsal and the performance. If you have a good babysitter or relative who would like to help in the dressing room, or you can volunteer yourself, please contact our Volunteer Coordinator.

GETTING READY BEFORE THE PERFORMANCE: Done At Home

Hair FOR CONCERT: Should be pulled back from face in a bun - No Bangs! Please use mousse and hairspray to keep hair neat and make certain that hair is secure and will last through the performance. *Makeup FOR CABARET* - Hairstyle will be specified by class and instructor; Makeup FOR BOTH-Light makeup including - Base, blush, mascara, and light lipstick. Jewelry - rings, necklaces, bracelets & watches are not allowed. No earrings unless the directors approve. This includes **small studs and huggie hoops.** NO nail polish.

- Dancers MUST Supply:
 - All Makeup
 - Tights clean and run-free
 - Shoes Clean with elastic sewn on
- Label ALL your dancers belongings. LDA and the venue will not be responsible for lost items. Even with names on items we will not guarantee a return of lost items.
- **DURING THE PERFORMANCE:** Costumes may NOT be taken out of the dressing rooms and should be returned to the room supervisor before your dancer leaves.

- Dancers will wait to be escorted to their dressing rooms by volunteers and/or assistants. Dancers should not leave the building without parental supervision.
- Parents are NOT allowed backstage at any time during the performance unless they are volunteering.
- This is a Family Event with most of the staff made up of volunteers and polite behavior is expected. Arguing with other patrons, staff, police, etc. or swearing will not be tolerated and may result in removal from the premises.
- Please be kind and put trash in the designated containers.
- Supervision Please make sure that your dancer arrives at the time indicated on the chart for all rehearsals and for the performances.
- Please leave your dancers clothing with them backstage so that they can be dressed in their street clothing after they've finished their performance and will be ready for pick up. Please pick up your dancer at the scheduled times.
- No dancer is allowed in the audience in the performance costume or dance class attire.
- To ensure that your dancer can join you for the rest of the performance, you must purchase a ticket and pick up your dancer at Intermission, then personally escort your dancer in the auditorium after they are out of costume and makeup.
- Videotaping of rehearsals and performances is NOT allowed.
- A professional photographer AND videographer will be at the performances a link of the performances, as well as photos, will be provided after the performance on our website for parents to download.

NEW Dancer Families: Please know that we expect parents to be in the audience for the entire act. Our performances are professional theatrical performances. For your enjoyment and the enjoyment of the entire audience please remain seated, but if you must leave, please do so ONLY between acts and return ONLY between acts.

PERFORMANCE TICKETS: Exciting news! This year, tickets will be available for purchase directly on our website for added convenience. While ticket processing will still be handled through a trusted third-party provider, you can now access everything in one place. Stay tuned for more details!
